State Hospital Workers & Small Business Owners Urge Governor Hogan to Keep Good Jobs in Carroll County

Eldersburg – Springfield Hospital workers, facing layoffs under Governor Larry Hogan’s budget proposal are urging local, small business owners to ask the governor to drop a plan that would eliminate nearly 60 jobs.
